- Resource for students, faculty, and staff regarding disability and accommodation issues.
 1. Undergraduate/graduate/professional school students with permanent and temporary disabilities.
 2. Review documentation and determine reasonable accommodations.
 3. Disabilities may include the following:
 - Psychological
 - Physical
 - ADHD
 - Chronic Health
 - Learning
 - Neurological
 - Hearing/Vision
 - Speech/Language



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- Accommodations
 - Classroom: note-taking, captioning, interpreting, alternative formats
 - Exams: extended time, separate testing
 - Program Modification: reduced course load
 - Campus Living: housing, dining, transportation, parking
- Provide referrals and resources
- Issue accommodation letters



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- Support faculty and staff as they implement accommodations.
- Communicate with departments to better understand course/program requirements.
 - Accommodations cannot fundamentally alter the nature of a course or program.



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- Disability as a diversity issue.
- Create campus climate which embraces concept of universal design.
